1.2 Greg then reported on several ongoing matters as follows:

### 1.2.1 Inter-Club events:

MCC had wins against RACV and Williamstown but lost against Kooyong and RSY.

**1.2.2** Acknowledgments: Greg Critchley thanked Sue and Laurie Kelso, Elissa Cohen, Anna Fowler, Ben Kingham and all committee members for their valuable contributions and assistance during the year in making the bridge club such an enjoyable place for playing bridge.

## 1.2.3 MCC Bridge Congress 2025

Greg stated that an inaugural MCC Bridge congress was in final stages of planning for Sunday 2 March 2025 at the 'G.

Bookings were currently open at a cost of \$100 per head inclusive of lunch via my ABF with Parking at the 'G available on a first come first served basis.

2 Treasurer's Report:

## 3 Election of the Committee:

Greg Critchley noted that Rick Gaylard and Andy Lee Hardie are retiring from the Committee and that two nominations to join the Committee have been received from Murray Linfoot and David Mckenzie to fill the vacant positions and whom were duly elected unanimously. As there were no other nominations for election to the Committee, pursuant to cause 4(g) of the Constitution, the continuing members of the Committee are deemed to be re-elected and so the new Committee will comprise Greg Critchley, Murray Linfoot, Alistair Minson, David McKenzie, Cally Marks, Sue McPhail and Petille Von Bibra.

#### **4 General Business**

- **4.1** In response to a question from Greg Baker requesting a status report on the state of the membership, Petile stated that the club has approximately 130 current members, 17 new members in the financial year ended 31 March 2024 plus an additional nine new members to date.
- **4.2** Greg then called for any further questions and as there were none, Linda Willersdorf thanked Greg and the Committee for their efforts in running the bridge club during the course of the year which was unanimously acclaimed.
